(What will happen at the end? Will you have something to show me? Go read my journal entry again, if necessary.)
  - c. At the end of the unit, you will write a test.

  - a. Click on 'Diagnostic.'
  - b. Complete the questions.

  - c. Choose a skill and start practising.'
